19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-29-102 is amended to read as follows:
20 12-29-102. Inmates denied participation in furlough programs.

21 A person who is convicted of any of the following offenses shall be
22 ineligible to participate in any meritorious furlough program conducted by or
23 for the Department of Correction:

24 (1) Capital murder, § 5-10-101;

25 (2) Murder in the first degree, § 5-10-102;

26 (3) Murder in the second degree, § 5-10-103;
