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2	SECTION 2. (a)(1) There is established a committee to be known as the
3	"Arkansas Workforce Investment Board and Adult Education Study Committee".
4	(b) The committee shall consist of twenty-six (26) members as follows:
5	(1)(A) Thirteen (13) members appointed by the Arkansas Workforce
6	Investment Board.
7	(B) Ten (10) of the members appointed by the Arkansas
8	Workforce Investment Board shall be a representative from a workforce center
9	in each of the ten (10) local workforce investment areas of the state; and
10	(2)(A) Thirteen (13) members appointed by the Adult Education
11	Section of the Department of Workforce Education.
12	(B) Ten (10) of the members appointed by the Adult
13	Education Section of the Department of Workforce Education shall be a
14	representative from an adult education program in each of the ten (10) local
15	workforce investment areas of the state.
16	(c) The appointed committee members shall be residents of the State of
17	Arkansas at the time of appointment and throughout his or her term.
18	(d) If a vacancy occurs in an appointed position, for any reason, the
19	vacancy shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment.
20	(2) The new appointee shall serve for the remainder of the
21	unexpired term.
22	(e) The Arkansas Workforce Investment Board and the Adult Education
23	Section of the Department of Workforce Education shall each name one (1)
24	member to serve as cochairs of the committee.
25	(f)(1) The cochairs of the committee shall call the first
26	organizational meeting within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this
27	act. The committee shall meet at times and places that either of the
28	cochairs deems necessary, but no meetings shall be held outside of the State
29	<u>of Arkansas.</u>
30	(2) A majority of the members of the committee shall constitute
31	a quorum for the purpose of transacting business.
32	(3) All action of the committee shall be by a majority vote of
33	the full membership of the committee.
34	(g) The committee shall:
35	(1) Review the programs and services offered by workforce
36	centers and adult education programs and determine if those entities offer

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1	duplicative services;
2	(2) Determine the extent to which workforce centers and adult
3	education programs are coordinating services to create a seamless system of

5	(3) Make specific recommendations for reducing unnecessary

9	Senate Interim Committee on Education on or before September 1, 2004, and an
10	oral report to the House Interim Committee on Education and the Senate

13	(h)(1) The Adult Education Section of the Department of Workforce
14	Education and Arkansas Workforce Investment Board shall provide staff and
15	meeting space to the committee.
16	(2)(A) Members of the committee shall serve without pay, except
17	members who receive compensation incidental to his or her regular employment.
18	(B) Members of the committee may receive expense
19	reimbursement in accordance with Arkansas Code § 25-16-902, to be paid by the
20	Adult Education Section of the Department of Workforce Education or Arkansas
21	Workforce Investment Board to the entities respective appointees and to the
22	extent money is available.

24	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
25	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Arkansas Workforce
26	Investment Board and Adult Education Study Committee needs to meet and
27	organize itself as soon as possible to begin the work of the committee.
28	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately
29	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall
30	become effective on:
31	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
32	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the
33	expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill;
34	<u>or</u>
35	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden,
36	the date the last house overrides the veto.
