19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. (a) The Assessment Coordination Department, established
22 under Arkansas Code § 25-28-101 et seq., and its powers, authorities, duties,
23 functions, records, property, unexpended balances of appropriations,
24 allocations, or other funds are transferred to the Public Service Commission.

25 (b) The duties transferred to the Public Service Commission under this
26 act include the following:

27 (1) Rulemaking;

28 (2) Regulation;

29 (3) Licensing;

30 (4) Promulgation of rules, regulations, rates, or standards;

31 (5) Licensing; and

32 (6) The rendering of findings, orders, and adjudications.

33 (c) All positions at the Assessment Coordination Department shall be
34 eliminated immediately before the transfer.
