19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-6-201(1)(A), concerning the definition of
22 approved political action committee to be used in the subchapter regarding
23 campaign financing, is amended to read as follows:

24 (1)(A) "Approved political action committee" means any person who:

25 (i) Receives contributions from one (1) or more persons in order
26 to make contributions to candidates, organized political parties, other
27 approved political actions, or other entities involved in the electoral
28 process;

29 (ii) Does not accept any contribution or cumulative
30 contributions in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) from any person in
31 any calendar year; and

32 (iii) Has been registered pursuant to § 7-6-215 for at least
33 four (4) continuous months prior to making contributions to candidates.
