19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 9, Chapter 10, Subchapter 2 is amended
22 to add an additional section to read as follows:

23 9-10-203. Donated sperm, ova, and embryos - Consent.

24 (a) It is unlawful for anyone to knowingly use sperm, ova, or embryos
25 in assisted reproduction technology, for any purpose other than the purpose
26 that is indicated in a written consent form signed by the sperm, ova, or
27 embryo provider.

28 (b) It is unlawful for anyone to knowingly implant sperm, ova, or
29 embryos through the use of assisted reproduction technology, into a recipient
30 who is not the sperm, ova, or embryo provider without a written consent form
31 signed by the sperm, ova, or embryo provider and recipient.

32 (c) Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of a Class D
33 felony.
