9 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE LONG TERM CARE PARTNERSHIPS  
10 AND TO PROVIDE STANDARDS GOVERNING LONG TERM CARE

12 ENCOURAGE CONSUMERS TO PURCHASE LONG TERM CARE

15 AUTHORIZE THE STATE INSURANCE DEPARTMENT TO ADOPT

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### SECTION 1. Purpose.

28 The purpose of this act is to:

29 (1) Authorize and provide standards governing long term care partnerships, if federal  
30 law is amended to encourage consumers to purchase long term care policies by providing  
31 enhanced protection of a consumer's assets under the Medicaid program; and  
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33 (2) Authorize the State Insurance Department to adopt rules to implement this act.  
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
