11	(a) It is the intent of this subchapter to supplement, not to		
12	supplant, funding for public education in this state.		
13	(b) Nothing in this subchapter shall be construed to reduce that		
14	portion of general revenue or growth revenues which would otherwise accrue to		
15	the Public School Fund.		
16	(c) The moneys provided by this subchapter are intended to be in		
17	addition to those anticipated to be provided to fund public education for the		
18	children of this state at the same historical proportional levels.

20	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-5-307 is repealed.		
21	6-5-307. Classroom teacher salary requirement.		
22	(a) Any increase in Educational Excellence Trust Fund funds allocated		
23	for teacher salaries may be used to fund the required salary increase		
24	provided for in this subsection, § 6-20-412, and § 6-17-2101 et seq., and		
25	required social security and teacher retirement matching for certified		
26	personnel may be paid from the funds.		
27	(b) Educational Excellence Trust Fund funds allocated for teacher		
28	salaries shall be disbursed by the Department of Education to school		
29	districts pursuant to the state equalization formula.		
30	(c) In determining if a school district has had an increase in		
31	Educational Excellence Trust Fund funds allocated for teacher salaries, any		
32	annual increase in such trust funds must exceed the level of the highest year
