For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO ALLOW A VOLUNTEER POLICE OFFICER TO
10 SEEK ELECTION TO THE CITY COUNCIL OR OTHER
11 GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OR TOWN; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES.

15 AN ACT TO ALLOW A VOLUNTEER POLICE

17 COUNCIL OR OTHER GOVERNING BODY OF THE
18 CITY OR TOWN.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-42-115 is amended to read as follows:
24 14-42-115. Volunteer fire fighter or volunteer police officer on
25 governing body.

26 (a)(1) It is lawful for a volunteer fire fighter or volunteer police
27 officer in any city of the first or second class or incorporated town in this
28 state to seek election to, and if elected, to serve as a member of the city
29 council or other governing body of the city or town.

30 (2) This service shall not be deemed a conflict of interest and
31 shall not be prohibited by the civil service regulations of any city or town.

32 (b) A person may serve and receive compensation as a member of the
33 governing body of any city of the first or second class or incorporated town
34 and simultaneously serve as a volunteer fire fighter or a volunteer police
35 officer and receive compensation as a fire fighter or a police officer.

36 (c) The provisions of this section shall not apply after August 13,
