BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
```

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-42-115 is amended to read as follows:
14-42-115. Volunteer fire fighter or volunteer police officer on governing body.
(a)(1) It is lawful for a volunteer fire fighter or volunteer police officer in any city of the first or second class or incorporated town in this state to seek election to, and if elected, to serve as a member of the city council or other governing body of the city or town.
(2) This service shall not be deemed a conflict of interest and shall not be prohibited by the civil service regulations of any city or town.
(b) A person may serve and receive compensation as a member of the governing body of any city of the first or second class or incorporated town and simultaneously serve as a volunteer fire fighter or a volunteer police officer and receive compensation as a fire fighter or a police officer.
(c) The provisions of this section shall not apply after August 13, 1993, to any city having a city administrator form of government.
