20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-6-223 is amended to read as follows:*

23 *7-6-223. Reports of contributions by political parties.*

24 *(a)(1) Organized political parties Within fifteen (15) calendar days*
25 *after the end of each calendar quarter, each political party as defined in §*
26 *7-1-101(16) shall file ~~an annual~~ a quarterly report with the Secretary of*
27 *State no later than January 15 of each year beginning in 1998, providing the*
28 *name, address, employer, and occupation of each person who made a*
29 *contribution or contributions to the political party ~~or any authorized~~*
30 *~~committee, which in the aggregate exceeded two hundred and fifty dollars~~*
31 *~~(\$250) fifty dollars (\$50.00) in the preceding calendar year quarter.~~*

32 *(2) The report shall include:*

33 *(A) ~~the~~ The date and amount of each such contribution;*

34 *(B) The total amount of money disbursed by the political*
35 *party; and*

36 *(C) An itemization including the amount of the*



1 disbursement, the name and address of the person to whom the disbursement was
2 made, and the date the disbursement was made for each single disbursement
3 that exceeds one hundred dollars (\$100).

4 (b)(1) Within fifteen (15) calendar days after the end of each
5 calendar quarter, each political party caucus of the General Assembly, the
6 Senate, or the House of Representatives shall file a quarterly report with
7 the Secretary of State providing the name, address, employer, and occupation
8 of each person who made a contribution or contributions to the political
9 party caucus, that in the aggregate exceeded fifty dollars (\$50.00) in the
10 preceding calendar quarter.

11 (2) The report shall include:

12 (A) The date and amount of each contribution;

13 (B) The total amount of money disbursed by the political
14 party caucus; and

15 (C) An itemization including the amount of the
16 disbursement, the name and address of the person to whom the disbursement was
17 made, and the date the disbursement was made for each single disbursement
18 that exceeds one hundred dollars (\$100).
