2	(a) In all contracts for the sale of timber in which the point of
3	measurement to determine the diameter of the log is not specifically provided
4	for, the diameter shall be determined by the diameter of the stump measured
5	at a point the same distance in inches above the ground as the diameter in
6	inches of the timber called for in the contract, regardless of how many
7	inches above the ground the log may have been severed.
8	(b) In determining the diameter of timber in sales provided for in
9	subsection (a), the measurement shall be made from the inside covering of one
10	bark to the outside covering of the other bark.
11	(c) Nothing in this section shall apply to cypress, tupelo gum, and
12	cottonwood.
13	(d) Any violation of this section shall be termed a trespass.
