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3	SECTION 2. (a)(1) Any facility which may qualify for the erection of			
4	one or more tourist-oriented directional signs shall submit their request for			
5	tourist-oriented directional sign or signs in writing to the Arkansas Highwa			
6	and Transportation Department.			
7	(2) The requesting facility shall be eligible for tourist-			
8	oriented directional signs only if it derives its major portion of income or			
9	visitors during the normal business season from road users not residing in			
10	the area of the facility.			
11	(b) The Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department, in			
12	consultation with the Arkansas Department of Parks and Tourism, shall place			
13	tourist-oriented directional signs along Arkansas streets, roads, and			
14	highways to inform road users of business, service, and activity facilities,			
15	which may include both publicly-owned and privately-owned facilities which			
16	meet the criteria defined in the Federal Manual on Uniform Traffic Control			
17	Devices, described in 23 U.S.C. 109(d) and 402(a) and in the Code of Federal			
18	Regulations, specifically 23 CFR 655, Subpart F, as were in effect on January			
19	<u>1, 2003.</u>			
20	(c) No facilities that qualify under the Federal Manual on Uniform			
21	Traffic Control Devices are excluded from eligibility for tourist-oriented			
22	directional signs.			
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
