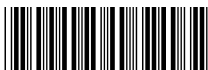
21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-11-415 is amended to read as follows:
24 24-11-415. Proceeds derived from sale of confiscated goods.

25 (a)(1) In all cities and towns, all goods confiscated by a police
26 officer of the city or by the sheriff or Arkansas State Police within the
27 city that are no longer needed as evidence shall be sold at auction, the
28 auction to be held at least annually or more often if the city determines
29 appropriate, and the proceeds derived from the sale of all confiscated goods
30 ~~that are required by the laws of this state to be sold if they were~~
31 ~~confiscated by a police officer of the city, by the sheriff, or by an officer~~
32 ~~of the Department of Arkansas State Police within the city~~ shall be deposited
33 in the city's policemen's pension and retirement fund.

34 (2) Subdivision (a)(1) of this section shall not supercede any
35 existing provisions of law governing the disposition of confiscated goods.

36 (b)(1) In all cities and towns, until such time as the pension and



1 retirement fund is actuarially sound as determined by the actuary under
2 contract with the Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Review Board, all moneys
3 confiscated by a police officer of the city, by the sheriff, or by an officer
4 of the Department of Arkansas State Police within the city shall be deposited
5 in the city's policemen's pension and retirement fund.

6 (2) Subdivision (b)(1) of this section shall not supercede any
7 existing provisions of law governing the disposition of confiscated moneys.

8 (3) At the time that the pension and retirement fund is
9 actuarially sound, all moneys received under this subsection shall be
10 retained by the city.
