## For An Act To Be Entitled

 AN ACT CONCERNING THE COLLECTION OF FINES BY INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS FOR DISTRICT AND CIRCUIT COURTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
## Subtitle

AN ACT CONCERNING THE COLLECTION OF
FINES BY INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS FOR
DISTRICT AND CIRCUIT COURTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-13-709(b), concerning private contractors collecting fines, is amended to read as follows:
(b)(1)(A) If a private contractor is selected to collect fines, then, to ensure the integrity of the court and to protect the county or city, the contractor shall register with the Secretary of State and shall file with the Secretary of State a surety bond or certificate of deposit.
(B) (i) Upon approval of the quorum court or the governing body of the city, a district or circuit court may authorize an independent contractor to administer the installment payments on fines.
(ii) As a condition of authorizing installment
payments, a district or circuit court may require the defendant to pay a fee for the service.
(2) The amount of the surety bond or certificate of deposit shall be fifty thousand dollars $(\$ 50,000)$.
(3) The county, city, or any person suffering damage by reason of the acts or omissions of the contractor may bring action on the bond for
damages.
(4) A contractor shall be ineligible to provide such services if the owner, operator, partner, or employee shall have been convicted of a felony.
