19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-13-709(b), concerning private
22 contractors collecting fines, is amended to read as follows:

23 (b)(1)(A) If a private contractor is selected to collect fines, then,
24 to ensure the integrity of the court and to protect the county or city, the
25 contractor shall register with the Secretary of State and shall file with the
26 Secretary of State a surety bond or certificate of deposit.

27 (B)(i) Upon approval of the quorum court or the governing
28 body of the city, a district or circuit court may authorize an independent
29 contractor to administer the installment payments on fines.

30 (ii) As a condition of authorizing installment
31 payments, a district or circuit court may require the defendant to pay a fee
32 for the service.

33 (2) The amount of the surety bond or certificate of deposit
34 shall be fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

35 (3) The county, city, or any person suffering damage by reason
36 of the acts or omissions of the contractor may bring action on the bond for



1 damages.

2 (4) A contractor shall be ineligible to provide such services if
3 the owner, operator, partner, or employee shall have been convicted of a
4 felony.
