24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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26 SECTION 1. (a) The purpose of this act is to provide for the
27 technology needs of Arkansas public schools serving the needs of students in
28 grades kindergarten through twelve (K-12) and provide a method to ensure that
29 all school districts and students have substantially equal access to
30 technology.

31 (b) The Department of Education shall adopt methods to help
32 school districts effectively teach students to use technology and to
33 incorporate technology into instruction for students.
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
