19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-65-120(a), concerning restricted driving
22 permits, is amended to read as follows:

23 5-65-120. Restricted driving permit.

24 (a) On July 1, 1996, and thereafter, the Office of Driver Services or
25 its designated agent, following the administrative hearing for suspension or
26 revocation of a driver's license as provided for in § 5-65-402, or upon the
27 request of the person whose privilege to drive has been denied or suspended,
28 may modify the denial or suspension in cases of extreme and unusual hardship
29 by the issuance of a restricted driving permit when, upon review of the
30 person's driving record for a time period of five (5) years prior to the
31 current suspension or denial of driving privilege, it is determined, at the
32 discretion of the Office of Driver Services or its designated agent, ~~that the~~
33 ~~person is not a multiple traffic law offender or~~ that the person does not
34 present a threat to the general public and that no other adequate means of
35 transportation exists for that person except to allow driving in any or all
36 of the following situations:



- 1 (1) To and from his or her place of employment;
- 2 (2) In the course of his or her employment;
- 3 (3) To and from an educational institution for the purpose of
- 4 attending classes if the person is enrolled and regularly attending classes
- 5 at the institution;
- 6 (4) To and from the alcohol safety education and treatment
- 7 course for drunk drivers; or
- 8 (5) To and from a hospital or clinic for medical treatment or
- 9 care for an illness, disease, or other medical condition of the driver or a
- 10 family member.
