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26	That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of

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33	SECTION 1. Section 14 of Article 19 of the Arkansas Constitution is
34	amended to read as follows:
35	§ 14. Lotteries <del>prohibited</del> .
36	No lottery shall be authorized by this State, nor shall the sale of

2	(a) Except as specifically provided in this section, all lotteries and
3	the sale of lottery tickets are prohibited.
4	(b)(1) The General Assembly may by law define lottery and provide for
5	the operation and regulation of a lottery or lotteries by or on behalf of the
6	state, and for any matters relating to the purposes or provisions of this
7	subsection.
8	(2) Proceeds derived from the lottery or lotteries operated by
9	or on behalf of the state shall be deposited into the State Treasury and used
10	to pay the operating expenses of the lottery or lotteries, including all
11	prizes, without any appropriation required by law, and for educational
12	programs and educational purposes as provided by the General Assembly.
13	(3) Net proceeds after payment of the operating expenses shall
14	be separately accounted for, and shall be specifically identified as $\underline{a}$
15	separate budget category entitled "Lottery Proceeds", and subject to
16	appropriation by the General Assembly solely for educational programs and
17	educational purposes.
18	(4) The General Assembly shall appropriate all net proceeds of
19	the lottery or lotteries by the separate budget category to educational
20	programs and educational purposes.
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22	SECTION 2. This amendment becomes effective on January 1, 2005.
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
