24 Section 1. Subdivision (b)(1) of Amendment 74 is amended to read as
25 follows:

26 (b)(1) There is established a uniform rate of ad valorem property tax
27 of ~~twenty-five (25)~~ thirty-five (35) mills to be levied on the assessed value
28 of all taxable real, personal, and utility property in the state to be used
29 solely for maintenance and operation of the schools.
