HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

9 PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO CHANGE THE UNIFORM RATE
10 OF AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAX FROM TWENTY-FIVE TO
11 THIRTY MILLS TO BE LEVIED ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY
12 IN THE STATE TO BE USED SOLELY FOR MAINTENANCE
13 AND OPERATION OF THE SCHOOLS.

16 PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO CHANGE THE
17 UNIFORM RATE OF AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAX
18 FROM TWENTY-FIVE TO THIRTY MILLS IN
19 AMENDMENT 74 OF THE ARKANSAS
20 CONSTITUTION.

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24 SECTION 1. Subdivision (b)(1) of Amendment 74 is amended to read as
25 follows:

26 (b)(1) There is established a uniform rate of ad valorem property tax
27 of ~~twenty five (25)~~ thirty (30) mills to be levied on the assessed value of
28 all taxable real, personal, and utility property in the state to be used
29 solely for maintenance and operation of the schools.

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31 SECTION 2. This amendment becomes effective on January 1, 2005.
