Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code§ 27-15-306 is amended to read as follows:
27-15-306. Enforcement.
(a) Any law enforcement official in this state is authorized to enter upon the public parking space of any public agency of this state for the purpose of enforcing the provisions of this subchapter with respect to accessible parking.
(b) Any law enforcement officer in this state is authorized to enter upon the parking space of any private agency in this state for the purpose of enforcing the provisions of this subchapter with respect to accessible parking.
(c) However, the exclusive parking privileges for disabled persons

under this subchapter are enforceable only:
    (1) In public parking spaces, during the normal business hours
of the public agency providing the public parking spaces; or
    (2) In the parking spaces of a private agency, during the
    regular business hours of the private business firm or person operating the
    business that provides the parking spaces.
