9 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 27-15-306 TO
10 LIMIT THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE EXCLUSIVE PARKING
11 PRIVILEGES FOR DISABLED PERSONS TO THE NORMAL
12 BUSINESS HOURS OF THE PUBLIC AGENCY OR PRIVATE
13 BUSINESS THAT PROVIDES THE PARKING SPACES; AND
14 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-15-306 is amended to read as follows:
27 27-15-306. Enforcement.

28 (a) Any law enforcement official in this state is authorized to enter
29 upon the public parking space of any public agency of this state for the
30 purpose of enforcing the provisions of this subchapter with respect to
31 accessible parking.

32 (b) Any law enforcement officer in this state is authorized to enter
33 upon the parking space of any private agency in this state for the purpose of
34 enforcing the provisions of this subchapter with respect to accessible
35 parking.

36 (c) However, the exclusive parking privileges for disabled persons

1 under this subchapter are enforceable only:

2 (1) In public parking spaces, during the normal business hours
3 of the public agency providing the public parking spaces; or

4 (2) In the parking spaces of a private agency, during the
5 regular business hours of the private business firm or person operating the
6 business that provides the parking spaces.
