29	(a)(1) The Board of Trustee	s of the Arkansas Publ	ic Employees'
30	Retirement System and the Arkansas	Teacher Retirement Sys	stem shall develop

33	(2) The former federal employee who becomes a member shall

4	(2) The provisions for determining a year of federal service

10	(c)(1)(A) The Board of Trustees of the Arkansas Public Employees'

12	policies and regulations to permit former members of each system who are		
13	working for the federal government to remove funds from the systems that were		
14	invested on the members' behalf.		
15	(B) The funds are payable to a federal government		
16	retirement system to purchase equivalent service credit in the federal system		
17	for the former member of the systems.		
18	(2)(A) The systems may pay to the federal systems the reserve		
19	value of any member's service credit with the consent of the former member.		
20	(B) The reserve value is the actuarial equivalent of the		
21	present value of any service credit that would be payable to the member at		
22	retirement age.		
23	(3) A payment made under this subsection (c) shall be a complete		
24	discharge of all liability under the systems for the former member's service.		
25	(d) The boards of trustees of the state system shall promulgate rules		
26	and regulations to coordinate their benefits with the benefits of the federal		
27	government retirement systems.		
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
