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- 1 (b)(1)(A) The commissioners shall be appointed by the mayor, shall be confirmed by a majority vote of the duly elected and qualified members of the city council, and shall hold office for a term of five (5) years.
 - (B) However, the first commissioners to be appointed and confirmed shall serve for terms of one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4), and five (5) years, respectively, to be designated by the mayor and city council, and thereafter, upon the expiration of their respective terms, commissioners appointed by the mayor and approved by a majority vote of the city council shall each be appointed for a term of five (5) years.
- 10 (2) The commissioners may be reappointed.

- (c)(1) In the event of a vacancy occurring on the commission, it shall be filled by appointment by the mayor, subject to the approval of a majority vote of the duly elected and qualified members of the city council.
 - (2) A vacancy shall be filled for the remainder of the term.
- 15 (d) Each commissioner shall file the oath required in the State of 16 Arkansas of public officials.
 - (e)(1) In the event the city council of any city votes to increase the membership of its parks and recreation commission from five (5) to seven (7) under subdivision (a)(2) of this section members, then the two (2) additional members of the commission shall be appointed in the manner provided in subsection (b) of this section and shall serve terms of five (5) years as provided in subdivision (e)(4) of this section. However, the first additional members appointed to the commission shall determine by lot their respective terms in order that the term of one (1) member shall be for three (3) years and the term of the other member shall be for five (5) years.
 - (2) Their successors shall be appointed for five-year terms.
 - (3) The members shall qualify in the same manner as provided in subsection (a) of this section for other commission members, and vacancies in either of the additional member positions shall be filled in the manner provided in subsection (c) of this section.
- 31 (4) Upon increasing the number of members of the commission, the 32 existing and additional commissioners shall serve initial terms as follow:
- 33 (A) For commissions of six (6) members, the initial terms
 34 shall be one (1) member each with terms for one (1), two (2), three (3), and
 35 four (4) years, and two (2) members with terms for five (5) years;
- 36 (B) For commissions of seven (7) members, the initial

15	(G) For commissions of twelve (12) members, the initial
16	terms shall be two (2) members with terms for one (1), two (2), and three (3)
17	years, and three (3) members with terms for four (4) and five (5) years;
18	(H) For commissions of thirteen (13) members, the initial
19	terms shall be two (2) members with terms for one (1) and two (2) years, and
20	three (3) members with terms for three (3), four (4), and five (5) years;
21	(I) For commissions of fourteen (14) members, the initial
22	terms shall be two (2) members with terms for (1) year, and three (3) members
23	with terms for two (2), three (3), four (4), and five (5) years; and
24	(J) For commissions of fifteen (15) members, the initial
25	terms shall be three (3) members with terms for one (1), two (2), three (3),
26	four (4), and five (5) years.
27	(f) Upon the appointment of the commissioners as provided in this
28	section, the mayor and city council shall execute such instruments and enact
29	such measures as may be necessary to vest complete charge of the municipally
30	owned parks and recreation facilities in the commissioners.
31	(g) Any commissioner appointed by the provisions of this section may
32	be removed for cause upon a two-thirds $(2/3)$ vote of the elected and
33	qualified members of the city council.
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
