21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 25-19-104 is amended to read as follows:  
24 25-19-104. Penalty.

25 Any person who negligently, knowingly, or purposely violates any of the  
26 provisions of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be  
27 punished by a fine of not more than two hundred dollars (\$200) or thirty (30)  
28 days in jail, or both, or a sentence of appropriate public service or  
29 education, or both.
