19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-39-304(a), concerning notices to cease  
22 trespassing, is amended to read as follows:

23 (a) The owner, agent, lessee, or assign of any lands including farm,  
24 timber, or otherwise may notify any person by ~~registered letter~~ certified  
25 mail, deliver to addressee only, by notice served by any official authorized  
26 to serve process, or by personal oral notification to cease any trespass, or  
27 to stay off the premises of any property belonging to the owner, his agent,  
28 or assigns.
