19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-61-105(a) is amended to read as follows:

22 (a) No college or university, normal school, or chartered institution  
23 of learning shall, under the authority of the State of Arkansas, grant to any  
24 student any baccalaureate degree unless he or she has passed a course in  
25 American history ~~and or~~ civil government ~~equivalent to that provided for in §~~  
26 ~~6-16-109 [repealed]~~.

28 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-61-106(a) is amended to read as follows:

29 (a) All colleges, and universities, ~~and other educational institutions~~  
30 in this state that are sustained or in any manner supported by public funds  
31 shall give instructions in the essentials of the United States Constitution,  
32 including the study of and devotion to American institutions and ideals.
