23	(a) It is the duty of all	trial and appellate c	ourts of this state,
24	and they are hereby vested with	the authority, to enco	urage the settlement of
25	cases and controversies pending	before them by advisin	g the reference thereof
26	suggesting the referral of the c	ase or controversy to	an appropriate dispute
27	resolution process agreeable to	the parties, and, on m	otion of all the
28	parties, must make such an order	of reference and cont	inue the case or
29	controversy pending the outcome	of the selected disput	e resolution process.
30	(b) In addition, all tria	al and appellate courts	of this state are
31	vested with the authority to ord	er any civil, juvenile	, except juvenile
32	delinquency, probate or domestic relations case or controversy pending before		
33	them to mediation.		
34	(c) If a case or controversy is ordered to mediation, the parties may:		
35	(1) Choose an appropriate mediator from a roster provided by the		
36	Arkansas Alternative Dispute Res	colution Commission of	those mediators who

1	meet the commission's requirement guidelines for that type of case; or		
2	(2) Select a mediator not on the commission's roster, if		
3	approved by the court.		
4	(d) A party may move to dispense with the order to mediate for good		
5	cause shown.		
6	(b)(e) All courts are further granted the discretionary		
7	authority to make, at the request of a party, appropriate orders to confirm		
8	and enforce the results produced by such dispute resolution process.
