18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-8-214 is amended to read as follows:

21 12-8-214. Award of pistol and purchase of shotgun upon retirement.

22 (a) When a state police officer retires from service or dies while
23 still employed with the Department of Arkansas State Police, the Arkansas
24 State Police Commission may, in recognition of and appreciation for the
25 service of the retiring or deceased officer, award to the officer, or the
26 officer's spouse, if the spouse is eligible under applicable state and
27 federal laws to possess a firearm, the pistol carried by the officer at the
28 time of his death or retirement from service.

29 (b) When a state police officer retires from service, the officer may
30 purchase the shotgun he or she used while on duty at the fair market value as
31 determined by the Commission.
