21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-5-705 is amended to read as follows:			
22	21-5-705. Financial identity fraud Payment of claim to survivors of

24	(a) The state shall pay the additional sum of seventy-five thousand			
25	dollars (\$75,000) to the surviving spouse or surviving children under the age			
26	of twenty-two (22) of any:			
27	(1) Police officer, wildlife enforcement officer of the Arkansas			
28	State Game and Fish Commission, commissioned law enforcement officer or			
29	emergency response employee of	emergency response employee of the State Parks Division of the Department of
