19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-5-705 is amended to read as follows:

22 21-5-705. ~~Financial identity fraud~~ Payment of claim to survivors of
23 certain specified public employees killed in the line of duty - Funds.

24 (a) The state shall pay the additional sum of seventy-five thousand
25 dollars (\$75,000) to the surviving spouse or surviving children under the age
26 of twenty-two (22) of any:

27 (1) Police officer, wildlife enforcement officer of the Arkansas
28 State Game and Fish Commission, commissioned law enforcement officer or
29 emergency response employee of the State Parks Division of the Department of
30 Parks and Tourism, Department of Community Correction employee, or employee
31 of the Department of Correction whose death occurred+

(A) ~~After July 1, 1987~~ January 1, 2003; and

(B) *Either:*

34 (i) *In the official line of duty and was the result*
35 *of a criminal or negligent action of another person or persons, or was the*
36 *result of the engagement in exceptionally hazardous duty; or*

1 (ii) In the line of duty while the officer or
2 employee was performing emergency medical activities; and

3 (2) Fire fighter or employee of the State Forestry Commission
4 killed after July 1, 1987, while responding to, engaging in, or returning
5 from a fire, a rescue incident, a hazardous material or bomb incident, an
6 emergency medical activity, or simulated training thereof.

7 (b) In addition to the benefits provided for in subsection (a) of this
8 section, the state shall pay the additional sum of twenty-five thousand
9 dollars (\$25,000) to the spouse or surviving children under the age of
10 twenty-two (22) of any police officer, wildlife enforcement officer of the
11 Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission, commissioned law enforcement officer
12 of the State Parks Division of the Department of Parks and Tourism,
13 Department of Community Correction employee, or employee of the Department of
14 Correction:

15 (1) Who was wearing a bulletproof vest approved by the Director
16 of the Department of Arkansas State Police; and

17 (2) Whose death occurred:

18 (A) After July 1, 1989; and

19 (B) In the official line of duty and was the result of a
20 criminal action of another person or persons.

21 (c) The benefits shall be paid totally from state funds appropriated
22 therefor. The funds shall not be reimbursed by a transfer or charging the
23 funds against any state funds allocated for turnback to cities or counties or
24 distributed to any other state department agency fund account other than the
25 Arkansas State Claims Commission fund accounts and the Miscellaneous
26 Revolving Fund Account.

27 (d) The additional benefits provided in this section shall be paid to
28 the surviving spouse, surviving children, or surviving parents in three (3)
29 equal annual payments, the first of which shall be paid in July of the next
30 fiscal year after the date of the original order of the Arkansas State Claims
31 Commission establishing entitlement to additional payments and annually
32 thereafter.

33 (e) Determination of eligibility for the additional payments provided
34 in this section shall be made by the Arkansas State Claims Commission in
35 accordance with commission rules and procedures.
