16 AN ACT TO EXEMPT PERSONS WORKING UNDER  
17 THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE  
18 AS SECURITY OFFICERS FROM LICENSING  
19 REQUIREMENTS UNDER THE PRIVATE  
20 INVESTIGATORS AND PRIVATE SECURITY

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
25

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-40-103(a)(3), concerning exemptions from  
27 licensing requirements under the Private Investigators and Private Security  
28 Agencies Act, is amended to read as follows:

29 (3) A person who has part-time or full-time employment as a law  
30 enforcement officer and who is certified by the Arkansas Commission on Law  
31 Enforcement Standards and Training as a law enforcement officer and receives  
32 compensation for private employment on an individual or an independent  
33 contractor basis as a patrolman, guard, or watchman if the person is:

34 (A)(i)(a) Employed in an employee-employer relationship;

35 or

36 ~~(i)(b)~~ Employed on an individual contractual



1 basis; and

2 ~~(B)(ii)~~ Not in the employ of another law enforcement

3 officer; or

4 (B) Working under the Department of Arkansas State Police

5 which is the security service contactor;
