1 as created by § 17-50-201; 2 (5) "Continuing Education" means a program approved by the commission designed to provide certificate or license holders further knowledge, skills, 3 4 or abilities in water well construction, pump installation, or related 5 activities; 6 (3)(6) "Heat pump circulating pipe" means pipes that circulate fluid 7 in heat pump wells and are a part of heat pump well construction, but are not 8 considered pumping equipment; 9 (4)(7)(A) "Heat pump wells" means any excavation that is drilled, 10 redrilled, cored, bored, washed, driven, dug, jetted, or otherwise 11 artificially constructed for the purpose of obtaining or exchanging 12 geothermal energy for use with ground water source air conditioning or heat 13 pump systems. 14 (B) The excavation may have pipes installed inside the 15 excavation to circulate or discharge various fluids for the use and purpose 16 set out in this subdivision (4)(7), and the well may or may not be backfilled 17 after excavation; (5)(8) "Person" includes any natural person, partnership, association, 18 19 business trust, and public or private corporation; 20 (9) "Pitless adapter" means an underground or above ground discharge 21 assembly that attaches directly to the well casing and extends the casing 22 above the ground surface, providing a watertight subsurface connection for 23 conducting water from the well, sealing out contaminants, protecting the 24 water from temperature extremes, and providing access to the pump or other 25 systems within the well; 26 (6)(A)(10) "Pump installer" means any natural person, whether or not 27 connected with a firm, partnership, corporation, or public or private 28 association, who engages for compensation in pump installation or repair and 29 who is authorized to plug abandoned water wells and to install pitless 30 <u>adapters</u>+; 31 (B) Registered pump installers who have demonstrated, in a 32 manner set forth in the commission's rules, a knowledge of the applicable 33 rules and required skills which are authorized to plug abandoned water wells; 34 (7)(11)(A) "Pumping equipment" means all machinery and parts of pumps 35 such as deep well turbine pumps with right angle gear drive, vertical hollow

shaft motors, jet pumps and motors, submersible pumps and motors, and other

1 parts and fittings installed or attached to the well. but 2 (B) "Pumping equipment" shall exclude cooling units, 3 horizontal electric motors, heat pump circulating pipe, and stationary diesel 4 or gas engines; 5 (8)(12) "Repair" means any action which results in a breaking, 6 opening, or replacement of a well seal or cap; 7 (9)(13) "Rig" means the machinery any power driven, percussion, 8 rotary, digging, jetting, direct push, vibrating, hydrofracturing, or 9 auguring machine used in the construction, alteration, or repair, or 10 abandonment of water wells, or the installation or repair of pumping 11 equipment, which has a lift or pulling capacity of greater than one thousand 12 pounds (1,000 lbs.); any hoist or machine used in installing or removing pumps from wells with a lifting capacity of one thousand pounds (1,000 lbs.) 13 14 or more; 15 (10)(14)(A) "Water well" means any excavation that is drilled, 16 redrilled, cored, bored, washed, driven, dug, jetted, or otherwise 17 artificially constructed for the purpose of locating, acquiring, diverting, 18 or artificially recharging ground water. 19 (B)(i) This term "Water well" shall also include excavations 20 made for the purpose of exchanging the geothermal energy found in the earth 21 as defined in the heat pump well subdivision (8)(7) of this section as heat 22 pump wells. but 23 (ii) "Water well" shall not include an excavation made for 24 the purpose of obtaining or prospecting for oil, natural gas, minerals, or 25 products of mining or quarrying, or for inserting media to repressure oil or 26 natural gas-bearing formations, or for storing petroleum, natural gas, or 27 other products; 28 (11)(15) "Water well contractor" means any person who engages in the 29 business of well construction or pump installation or repair, exclusive of 30 surveying or other acts preparatory to the construction of a water well; 31 (12)(16) "Water well driller" means any natural person, whether or not 32 connected with a firm, partnership, corporation, or other public or private 33 association, who engages for compensation in well construction in this state; 34 and 35 (13)(17) "Well construction" means the act of setting up the rig for 36 and engaging in the excavation of a water well, the modification of the

- 1 borehole, and the setting or removal of easing, casing up to the point of
- 2 installing or repairing pump equipment, and plugging abandoned water wells.

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- SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-50-104(a)(1), concerning unlawful water well construction, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Any person to engage in well construction or pump
  7 installation, unless the work is performed under the supervision of an
  8 individual <del>licensed or</del> certified by the Commission on Water Well Construction
  9 in the type of work done;

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- 11 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 17-50-105 is amended to read as follows: 12 17-50-105. Criminal penalties.
- (a) Any person who shall violate § 17-50-104 shall be guilty of a

  Class A misdemeanor and punished by a fine of not less than fifty dollars

  (\$50.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500) or by imprisonment in the

  county jail for not less than one (1) month nor more than six (6) months, or

  by both.
  - (b) Any person who violates any other provision of this chapter, regulations issued hereunder under this chapter, or order pursuant hereto to this chapter shall be guilty of a Class B misdemeanor and subject to a penalty not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100).
  - (c) Every day, or any part thereof of a day, in which the violation occurs shall constitute a separate offense.
    - (d) Any person found guilty of a Class A or B misdemeanor for violation of any provision of this chapter who continues to engage in the behavior or activity giving rise to violation shall be guilty of a Class D felony for the second or any subsequent offense.
  - (c)(e) Persons described in subsections (a) and (b) of this section may be arrested by any sheriff, constable, chief of police, or other law enforcement officer of this state or any political subdivision thereof of this state.

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4	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 17-50-109 (3), concerning service of
5	process for the Commission on Water Well Construction, is amended to read as
6	follows:
7	(3) The notice shall be served in the manner required by law for
8	the service of process upon a person in a civil action or by an employee of
9	the commission and may be accompanied by an order of the commission requiring
10	described remedial action which, if taken within the time specified in the
11	order, will effect compliance with the requirements of this chapter and
12	regulations issued hereunder;
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14	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 17-50-301 is amended to read as follows:
15	17-50-301. Certificate - Applicant qualifications.
16	(a) Upon proper application to the Commission on Water Well
17	Construction, any person shall be entitled to be registered and to be issued
18	a certificate of registration as a certified water well driller or certified
19	pump installer who shall furnish to the commission proof that he or she:
20	(1) Is not less than eighteen (18) years of age;
21	(2) Is of good moral character;
22	(3) Has knowledge of the rules and regulations adopted
23	under this chapter; and
24	(4) $\frac{(A)}{(A)}$ Has had no fewer <u>less</u> than two (2) years of
25	experience <u>as defined by the commission's rules</u> in the work for which he or
26	she is applying for a certificate of registration.
27	(B) However, applicants for pump installer certification
28	may substitute forty (40) hours of instruction approved by the commission for
29	the experience requirement.
30	(b) The commission shall provide examinations and a course of
31	instruction, when required, which each applicant must pass in order to
32	qualify for the certificate of registration.
33	(c) Any person engaged in the business of pump installation shall be
34	registered and issued a certificate of registration after passing an
35	examination if:
36	(1) The applicant has been engaged for a period of at least two

1	(2) years in the business of pump installation for domestic wells and wells
2	which produce less than fifty thousand (50,000) gallons per day; and
3	(2) The applicant makes application and pays the required fees
4	for registration.
5	(c) Beginning July 1, 2005, any person applying to be registered as a
6	certified water well driller or certified pump installer shall have:
7	(1) Completed the apprenticeship program;
8	(2) In the past ten (10) years, held a valid certificate of
9	registration from the commission of the type and class for which the
10	applicant is applying; or
11	(3) A valid certificate from another state of a type and class
12	substantially similar to the type and class for which the person is applying
13	for a period of years that equals the apprenticeship program requirement.
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15	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 17-50-302 is amended to read as follows:
16	17-50-302. Certificate - Reciprocity.
17	Upon application for a certificate, and the payment of the proper
18	registration and testing fees, and upon passage of the applicable test, the
19	Commission on Water Well Construction may issue a certificate of registration
20	to any person who holds a certificate of qualification or registration issued
21	to him or her by proper authority in any state, territory, or possession of
22	the United States or of any other country, if:
23	(1) The registration standard under which the certificate was
24	issued is of a standard not lower than that specified by the provisions of
25	this chapter and the rules of the commission promulgated pursuant to the
26	provisions hereof; and
27	(2) That particular state, territory, or possession of the
28	United States or other country extends similar privileges to the persons
29	registered under the provisions of this chapter.
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31	SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 17-50-303 is amended to read as follows:
32	17-50-303. Certificate - Expiration and renewal.
33	(a) Certificates of registration issued pursuant to this chapter are
34	not transferable and shall expire on July 31 of each year.
35	(b) A certificate of registration may be renewed without examination

by making application for a certificate and paying the applicable fee.

1	(c) As a condition for renewal of certificates of registration, the
2	commission may require the person holding the certificate to complete a
3	program of continuing education.
4	(c)(d) If any person issued a water well driller certificate of
5	registration under this chapter shall fail to make application for renewal
6	thereof within one (1) year after the expiration of the certificate of
7	registration, the certificate of registration of the person shall be renewed
8	only upon application, examination, and payment of the applicable fee plus a
9	penalty of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).
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11	SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 17-50-305(a), concerning rules for
12	application for and issuance of water well contractor licenses, is amended to
13	read as follows:
14	(a) $\underline{(1)}$ The Commission on Water Well Construction may adopt, and from
15	time to time amend or repeal, rules and regulations governing applications
16	for water well contractor licenses.
17	(2) The commission shall license as a water well contractor any
18	person properly making application therefor on a form prepared and furnished
19	by the commission.
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21	SECTION 10. Arkansas Code § 17-50-307 is amended to read as follows:
22	17-50-307. License - Expiration and renewal.
23	(a) Licenses issued pursuant to this subchapter are not transferable
24	and shall expire on July 31 of each year.
25	(b) As a condition for license renewal the commission may require the
26	licensee or its agent to complete a program of continuing education.
27	(b)(1)(c)(1)(A) A license may be renewed for an ensuing year by making
28	application not The contractor shall renew the license annually by applying
29	$\underline{\text{no}}$ later than thirty (30) days after the expiration date and paying the
30	applicable fee.
31	(B) The application shall have the effect of extending
32	When the contractor submits the renewal materials and fee, the commission
33	$\underline{\text{shall extend}}$ the validity of the current license until $\underline{\text{a}}$ $\underline{\text{the contractor}}$
34	receives the new license is received or the applicant is notified by the

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5 SECTION 11. Arkansas Code § 17-50-308 is amended to read as follows:
6 17-50-308. License - Suspension and revocation.

- (a) Whenever the Commission on Water Well Construction, after notice and hearing, determines that the holder of a license issued pursuant to this subchapter has violated any provision of this chapter, or any rule or regulation adopted pursuant to it, the commission is authorized to suspend or revoke the license.
- (b) Any The commission shall serve any order issued pursuant to this section shall be served upon the licensee by certified mail with return receipt requested or by personal service.
- 15 (c) Any such order shall become effective upon return of receipt to the commission.
  - (d) Any person aggrieved by any order issued after the hearing may appeal within thirty (30) days appeal therefrom to the circuit court of the county wherein where that person resides or to the Pulaski County Circuit Court.

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- 22 SECTION 12. Arkansas Code § 17-50-309(c), concerning bonds for water 23 well contractors, is amended to read as follows:

- 30 (a)(1) The Commission on Water Well Construction shall issue rig
  31 permits where the applicant therefor if the contractor has a valid license,
  32 has made proper application for a rig permit, and has paid the required fee.
- 33  $\frac{\text{(b)}(2)}{\text{(2)}}$  Rig permits shall not be transferable and shall expire 34 July 31 of each year.
- 35 (c)(1)(b)(1)(A) A rig permit may be renewed for an ensuing year by
  36 making application not The contractor must renew the rig permit annually by

  2 the required fee.
- 3 (B) The application shall have the effect of extending
- 4 After receiving the renewal materials and fee, the commission shall extend
- 5 the validity of the current rig permit until  $\frac{1}{2}$  the contractor receives the
- 6 new rig permit is received or the applicant is notified by the commission
- 7 that it or until the contractor receives notice that the commission has
- 8 refused to renew the rig permit.
- 9 (2) After August 31 of each year, the commission shall only renew a

- 28 fees for any license or rig permit even though it may be valid for less than
- 29 a full license or permit year.

- 31 SECTION 15. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 50, Subchapter 3 is
- 32 amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
- 33 17-50-312. Apprenticeship program.
- 34 (a) The commission shall develop an apprenticeship program to assist
- 35 persons applying for registration and having a minimum level of knowledge,
- 36 skills, and abilities for the type or class of registration for which they

T	are applying.
2	(b)(1) The program shall include the following:
3	(A) Registration and issuance of a certificate of
4	apprenticeship for the type or class of registration for which the apprentice
5	will be applying; and
6	(B) Supervision of the apprentice by a person holding a
7	valid certificate or certificates of registration of the type or class for
8	which the apprentice will be applying.
9	(2) The supervising certificate holder shall report to the
10	$\underline{\text{commission at the time of certificate of apprenticeship registration renewal}}\\$
11	that the apprentice is successfully obtaining the necessary knowledge,
12	skills, and abilities for the type or class of certificate for which the
13	apprentice will be applying.
14	(3) The apprenticeship program requirement shall not exceed four
15	(4) years.
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17	SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
18	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that water wells are currently
19	being improperly drilled in a manner that poses an imminent threat to the
20	water supply in this state; and that the protections included in this act
21	must be implemented immediately to prevent injury to the public. Therefore,
22	an emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for the
23	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
24	on July 1, 2003.
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
