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27	SECTION 1. Ark	ansas Code § 14-268-102 is amended to	read as follows:
28	14-268-102. De	finition Definitions.	
29	As used in this	chapter, unless the context otherwise	e requires, :
30	<u>(1) "Com</u>	mission" means the Arkansas Soil and V	Water Conservation
31	Commission;		
32	(2) "Flo	odplain administrator" means the perso	on designated by a
33	city, town, or a coun	ty, to administer and implement this o	chapter and other
34	federal and state laws and local ordinances and regulations relating to the		
35	management of flood-p	rone areas; and	
36	<u>(3)</u> "Flo	od-prone areas" means areas that are s	subject to, or are

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1	exposed to, flooding and flood damage.
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3	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-268-103 is amended to read as follows:
4	14-268-103. Penalty.
5	Any person or corporation who violates any measure adopted under this
6	chapter may be fined not more than one hundred dollars (\$100) five hundred
7	$\underline{\text{dollars (\$500)}}$ for each offense. Each day during which a violation exists is
8	a separate offense.
9	
10	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Title 14, Chapter 268, is amended to add an
11	additional section to read as follows:
12	14-268-106. Floodplain administrator.
13	(a) Each county, city, or town ordinance adopted under this chapter
14	shall designate a person to serve as the floodplain administrator to
15	administer and implement the ordinance and any local codes and regulations
16	relating to the management of flood-prone areas.
17	(b) Beginning July 1, 2004, each floodplain administrator shall become
18	accredited by the Arkansas Soil and Water Conservation Commission under the
19	commission's authority regarding flood control under §§ 15-24-102 and 15-24-
20	<u>109.</u>
21	
22	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 15-24-102(a), concerning the flood control
23	powers and duties of the Arkansas Soil and Water Conservation Commission, is
24	amended to read as follows:
25	(a) It shall be the duty of the Arkansas Soil and Water Conservation
26	Commission to:
27	(1) Study, consider, and determine upon a sound public policy
28	with regard to flood prevention, flood control, and flood protection; and
29	(2) Compile figures on flood damage current and past and
30	information and other information on current and previous flood damage and
31	scientific data relative to the recurrence of floods such as rainfall,
32	runoff, flowing channels, stream obstruction, existing facilities for storing
33	surplus waters, and existing protection works; and
34	(3) Accredit persons having requisite knowledge in floodplain
35	management and in minimization and prevention of flood hazards and losses.

1	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code Title 15, Chapter 24, is amended to add an		
2	additional section to read as follows:		
3	15-24-109. Accreditation of floodplain administrators.		
4	(a)(l) In determining accreditation standards for floodplain		
5	administrators, the Arkansas Soil and Water Conservation Commission may		
6	consider an applicant's knowledge, experience, skills, and training in		
7	floodplain management and in minimization and prevention of flood hazards and		
8	losses.		
9	(2) The accreditation standards may include:		
10	(A) Passage of an examination;		
11	(B) Completion of approved training; or		
12	(C) Certification by a nationally recognized floodplain		
13	management organization.		
14	(b) Continuing training may be required for persons who want continued		
15	accreditation.		
16	(c) The commission may charge accreditation fees in amounts up to the		
17	following:		
18	(1) Original accreditation, thirty dollars (\$30.00);		
19	(2) Annual renewal of accreditation, twenty dollars (\$20.00);		
20	<u>and</u>		
21	(3) Late fee for renewal after thirty (30) days, fifteen dollars		
22	<u>(\$15.00).</u>		
23	(d)(l) Accreditation fees collected are cash funds and shall not be		
24	deposited in the State Treasury.		
25	(2) The cash funds shall be held and applied by the commission		
26	solely for the uses under this subchapter.		
27	(3) The cash funds shall not be deemed to be a part of the State		
28	Treasury for any purpose, including, without limitation, the provisions of		
29	Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 29, Article 16, § 12, or Arkansas		
30	Constitution, Amendment 20, or any other constitutional or statutory		
31	provision.		
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
