13	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 21-5-411(a)(3)(C), concerning eligibility		
14	of certain retired employees for state employees' health insurance benefits,		
15	is amended to read as follows:		
16	(C)(i) Except as provided in subdivision (a)(3)(C)(ii) of		
17	this section, an inactive retiree's failure to make an election during the		
18	thirty-one-day election period or an inactive retiree's election to decline		
19	participation in the health program is final.		
20	(ii)(a) If an inactive retiree declining coverage		
21	specifies in writing that the reason for the declination is because the		
22	inactive retiree has coverage through another insurance program or group		
23	health plan and the inactive retiree's coverage is subsequently terminated		
24	because of a loss of eligibility, then the inactive retiree and any		
25	dependents shall qualify for coverage in a board-sponsored health benefit		
26	program upon payment of the appropriate premium as established by the board,		
27	provided the inactive retiree applies for coverage within thirty-one (31)		
28	days of the loss of eligibility.		
29	(b) If an inactive retiree declining coverage		
30	specifies in writing that the retiree declined coverage because the retiree		
31	was covered through the spouse's coverage under the health benefit program		
32	under this subchapter, then the inactive retiree is qualified for coverage		
33	$\underline{\text{under the health benefit program upon payment of the appropriate premium } \underline{\text{as}}$		
34	established by the board.		

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
