## Subtitle

TO INCREASE THE HEIGHT LIMITS FOR
VEHICLES ON STREETS AND HIGHWAYS IN
ARKANSAS FROM THIRTEEN FEET, SIX INCHES
(13' 6") TO FOURTEEN FEET (14').

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-35-109(b), concerning liability for highway structures, is amended to read as follows:
(b) Any person driving any vehicle, object, or contrivance upon any highway shall be liable for all damages to structures spanning the highway, or a part of the highway, by reason of load heights in excess of that which the structure will permit, when the clearance height of the structure is posted, and in any event where the height of the vehicle and load is in excess of thirteen feet, six inches ( $13,6^{\prime \prime}$ ) fourteen feet (14').

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-35-207 is amended to read as follows:
27-35-207. Height of vehicles.
No vehicle operated upon the highways of this state, unladen or with load, shall exceed a height of thirteen feet, six inches ( $13^{\prime}, 6^{\prime \prime}$ ) fourteen feet (14'), unless a greater height is authorized by a special permit issued
by competent authority as provided in § 27-35-210.
