21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-35-109(b), concerning liability for
24 highway structures, is amended to read as follows:

25 (b) Any person driving any vehicle, object, or contrivance upon any
26 highway shall be liable for all damages to structures spanning the highway,
27 or a part of the highway, by reason of load heights in excess of that which
28 the structure will permit, when the clearance height of the structure is
29 posted, and in any event where the height of the vehicle and load is in
30 excess of ~~thirteen feet, six inches (13' 6")~~ fourteen feet (14').

32 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-35-207 is amended to read as follows:

33 27-35-207. Height of vehicles.

34 No vehicle operated upon the highways of this state, unladen or with
35 load, shall exceed a height of ~~thirteen feet, six inches (13' 6")~~ fourteen
36 feet (14'), unless a greater height is authorized by a special permit issued



1 by competent authority as provided in § 27-35-210.
