## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 2l, Chapter 12, Subchapter 5 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

21-12-504. State agencies required to report impending layoffs of state employees.
(a) Any state agency, board, or commission that announces a layoff of state employees shall file a report as soon as possible with the Legislative Council and the Office of Personnel Management of the Division of the Division of Management Services of the Department of Finance and

Administration.
(b) The report shall include the job titles and programs involved in the impending layoff.
(c) It is the responsibility of the Office of Personnel Management and Bureau of Legislative Research to insure that the eliminated positions are
removed from the agency, institutions, board, or commission budget for the next biennium.
(d) This section does not apply to institutions of higher education. /s/ Faris
