12 TEACHERS CONFERENCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 11, Chapter 4, Subchapter 6, is amended
25 to add an additional section to read as follows:

26 11-4-613. Unpaid leave to attend parent-teacher conferences.

27 (a) For purposes of this section:

28 (1) "Employee" means a person performing work or service of any
29 kind or character for compensation;

30 (2) "Employer" means a person employing a person for
31 compensation;

32 (3) "Parent" means:

33 (A) A natural parent; or

34 (B) A person with whom the student resides if the person

35 is:

36 (i) A stepparent;



1 (ii) Legal guardian;
2 (iii) Person in loco parentis; or
3 (iv) Person who has legal custody of a student under
4 a court order; and

5 (4) Parent-teacher conference means a meeting regularly
6 scheduled by a school district for the purpose of allowing a parent to meet
7 with their child's teacher to discuss a student's academic progress.

8 (b)(1) All employers shall allow an employee who is a parent and has a
9 child enrolled in Arkansas public schools to take unpaid leave to attend a
10 parent-teacher conference.

11 (2) The unpaid leave shall be allowed up to but no less than two
12 (2) times during the school year.

13 (3) Each unpaid leave for a parent-teacher conference shall be
14 up to but no less than three (3) hours.

15 (c) No employer shall retaliate against any employee who exercises the
16 option created under this section.

17 (d)(1) It shall be the duty of the Director of the Department of Labor
18 to enforce the provisions of this section in accordance with all of the
19 rights and duties allowed the director under Title 11, Chapter 2 of the
20 Arkansas Code.

21 (2) Any employer who fails to comply with, or directly or
22 indirectly evades the provisions of this section, shall be deemed guilty of a
23 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100)
24 nor more than one thousand dollars (\$1000) to be paid into the common school
25 fund for the school district in which the parent-teacher conference was
26 scheduled.
