9 AN ACT TO ENCOURAGE PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT IN THEIR
10 CHILD'S EDUCATION BY REQUIRING EMPLOYERS TO ALLOW
11 PARENTS TO TAKE UNPAID LEAVE TO ATTEND PARENT-
12 TEACHERS CONFERENCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 11, Chapter 4, Subchapter 6, is amended
25 to add an additional section to read as follows:

26 11-4-613. Unpaid leave to attend parent-teacher conferences.

27 (a) For purposes of this section:

28 (1) "Employee" means a person performing work or service of any
29 kind or character for compensation;

30 (2) "Employer" means a person employing a person for
31 compensation;

32 (3) "Parent" means:

33 (A) A natural parent; or

34 (B) A person with whom the student resides if the person

35 is:

36 (i) A stepparent;



1 (ii) Legal guardian;
2 (iii) Person in loco parentis; or
3 (iv) Person who has legal custody of a student under
4 a court order; and

5 (4) "Parent-teacher conference" means a meeting regularly
6 scheduled by a school district for the purpose of allowing a parent to meet
7 with their child's teacher to discuss a student's academic progress.

8 (b)(1) All employers shall allow an employee who is a parent and has a
9 child enrolled in Arkansas public schools to take unpaid leave to attend a
10 parent-teacher conference.

11 (2) The unpaid leave shall be allowed up to but no less than two
12 (2) times during the school year.

13 (3) Each unpaid leave for a parent-teacher conference shall be
14 up to but no less than three (3) hours.

15 (4) No less than ten (10) calendar days prior to the taking of
16 leave to attend a parent-teacher conference, the employee shall provide
17 written notification of his or her intent to his or her immediate supervisor
18 or other appropriate person necessary to obtain leave authorization.

19 (5) Upon request by the parent, the school district shall
20 provide written verification of the parent's attendance at the parent-teacher
21 conference, which shall include the name of the parent, the date of the
22 parent-teacher conference, the time of the parent-teacher conference, and a
23 statement confirming the employee's attendance.

24 (c) No employer shall retaliate against any employee who exercises the
25 option created under this section.

26 (d)(1) It shall be the duty of the Director of the Department of Labor
27 to enforce the provisions of this section in accordance with all of the
28 rights and duties allowed the director under Title 11, Chapter 2 of the
29 Arkansas Code.

30 (2) Any employer who fails to comply with, or directly or
31 indirectly evades the provisions of this section, shall be deemed guilty of a
32 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100)
33 nor more than one thousand dollars (\$1000) to be paid into the common school
34 fund for the school district in which the parent-teacher conference was
35 schedule.

36 (e)(1) The Governor may, by proclamation, suspend the provisions of

1 this section during times of state or national crisis, or other times the
2 Governor deems necessary to ensure sufficient levels of production in the
3 workplace.

4 (2) The Governor shall cause any proclamation under subsection
5 (e) to be:

6 (A) Published in a newspaper in general circulation for no
7 less than five (5) days; and

8 (B) To be delivered to the Co-chairs of the Legislative
9 Council of the General Assembly.
