9 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF  
10 STATE POLICE TO ISSUE A USED MOTOR VEHICLE  
11 DEALER'S LICENSE ON THE CONDITION THAT A  
12 SUBSEQUENT INSPECTION IS CONDUCTED OF THE  
13 DEALER'S FACILITY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

16 TO ALLOW THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF  
17 STATE POLICE TO ISSUE A USED MOTOR  
18 VEHICLE DEALER'S LICENSE ON THE  
19 CONDITION THAT A SUBSEQUENT INSPECTION  
20 IS CONDUCTED OF THE DEALER'S FACILITY.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
24

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 23-112-607(b)(11), concerning the required  
26 information that the Arkansas Department of State Police must verify to issue  
27 a used motor vehicle dealer's license, is amended to read as follows:

28 (11)(A) An affidavit from a Department of Arkansas State Police  
29 officer stating that the officer has inspected the facility and found it to  
30 be in compliance with the requirements for application; ~~and or~~

31 (B)(i) An affidavit from a Department of Arkansas State  
32 Police officer stating that the facility is scheduled to be inspected and, if  
33 the facility was in compliance with the requirements for application on the  
34 last inspection, the facility may be issued a provisional license conditioned  
35 on the facility being successfully inspected later in the year;

36 (ii) However, the dealer's license shall be



1 suspended immediately if the facility is found not to be in compliance with  
2 the requirements for application; and
