24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-37-704 is repealed.

28 ~~No motor vehicle, nor the operator of such vehicle, nor the passengers~~
29 ~~of such vehicle shall be stopped, inspected, or detained solely to determine~~

32 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-37-706 is amended to read as follows:

33 27-37-706. Penalties - Court costs.

34 (a) Any person who violates this subchapter shall be subject to a fine
35 ~~not to exceed~~ of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).

36 (b) When a person is convicted, pleads guilty, pleads nolo contendere,



1 or forfeits bond for violation of this subchapter, no court costs or other
