Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

an act to repeal arkansas Code § 25-1-206; and FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO REPEAL ARKANSAS CODE § 25-1206; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-1-206, an exemption from the state agency paper reduction law, is repealed.

25-1-206. Definition of "state agency".
The term "state agency" as used in this subchapter does not include institutions of higher education.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 25-1-203(c), listing publications which are exempt from the paper reduction law, is amended by adding an additional subdivision to read as follows:
(11) Information, brochures, and catalogs distributed by an institution of higher education to any prospective student.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 25-1-203 is amended by adding an additional subsection to read as follows:
(f)(1) For the period January 1, 2004, through December 31, 2005, any state publication may be distributed by an institution of higher education notwithstanding other provisions of this subchapter, but the publication shall contain information notifying the recipient of the right to be removed
from the distribution list.
(2) The notice shall provide an address, which may be an e-mail address, and phone number to notify the institution of higher education to remove the recipient's name from the distribution list.

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective on January 1, 2004.
