9	(C) Digital data acquisition and development including but

12	(4) The information technologies shall be consistent with

15	(e)(1) Sixty percent (60%) of the fees collected in each county shall		
16	be deposited into the County Technology and Digital Mapping Fund.		
17	(2) Forty percent (40%) of the amount collected shall be		
18	transmitted by the county treasurer to the Treasurer of State for deposit		
19	into the Geographic Information Systems Fund for the purpose of assisting in		
20	land records modernization using current digital data standards, and for the		
21	development and distribution of that data to the public.		
22	(f) The Arkansas State Land Information Board shall establish policies		
23	to monitor technology progress, and provide for accountability, in the use of		
24	the funds collected under this section.		
25	(g) All land records data development shall be coordinated with the		
26	Arkansas Geographic Information Office.		
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
