13 ARE NOT WEARING SAFETY BELTS; ESTABLISH

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-37-704 is repealed.

26 ~~27-37-704. Inspection for compliance.~~

27 ~~No motor vehicle, nor the operator of such vehicle, nor the passengers of such vehicle~~  
28 ~~shall be stopped, inspected, or detained solely to determine compliance with this subchapter.~~

30 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-37-706 is amended to read as follows:

31 27-37-706. Penalties - Court costs.

32 (a) Any person who violates this subchapter shall be subject to a fine ~~not to exceed~~ of  
33 twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).

34 (b) When a person is convicted, pleads guilty, pleads nolo contendere, or forfeits bond  
35 for violation of this subchapter, no court costs or other costs or fees shall be assessed.
