25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 10-3-403(a)(1)(A) is amended to read as
28 follows:

29 (1)(A) ~~Sometime before adjournment of each regular session, the Senate~~
30 ~~shall select sixteen (16) members, with four (4) to be chosen from each of~~
31 ~~the four (4) congressional districts in effect on January 1, 1987, by caucus~~
32 ~~of the Senators residing in their respective congressional districts. The~~
33 Senate shall select sixteen (16) members in accordance with procedures
34 prescribed by Senate Rules.

36 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 10-3-502(c)(1) is amended to read as follows:



1 (c)(1) The Senate members of the Committee shall be selected ~~as~~
2 ~~follows: Five (5) members from each congressional district as they existed on~~
3 ~~March 1, 1991, based on seniority within the Senate~~ in accordance with
4 procedures prescribed by Senate Rules.
