Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE §§ 10-3-403 AND 10-3-502 TO PROVIDE THAT SENATE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE JOINT AUDITING COMMITTEE AND THE JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE SHALL BE SELECTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROCEDURES PRESCRIBED IN THE SENATE RULES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO PROVIDE THAT SENATE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE JOINT AUDITING COMMITTEE AND THE JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE SHALL BE SELECTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROCEDURES PRESCRIBED IN THE SENATE RULES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 10-3-403(a)(1)(A) is amended to read as follows:
(1) (A) Sometime before adjournment of each regular session, the Senate shall select sixteen (16) members, with four (4) to be chosen from each of the four (4) congressional districts in effect on January 1, 1987, by caucus of the Senators residing in their respective congressional districts. The Senate shall select sixteen (16) members in accordance with procedures prescribed by Senate Rules.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code $10-3-502(\mathrm{c})(1)$ is amended to read as follows:
