22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-7-108, regarding the disposition of  
25 funds, is amended to read as follows:

26 3-7-108. Disposition of funds.

27 (a)(1) All taxes, penalties, and costs collected by the Director of  
28 the Department of Finance and Administration under ~~the provisions of §§ 3-7-~~  
29 ~~101 - 3-7-104 and 3-7-106 - 3-7-110, with the exception of the tax allocated~~  
30 in subsection (b) of this section, shall be general revenues and shall be  
31 deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Apportionment  
32 Fund.

33 (2) The Treasurer of State, on or before the fifth day of the  
34 month next following the month during which such funds shall have been  
35 received by him or her, shall allocate and transfer the funds to the various  
36 State Treasury funds in the proportions to each as provided by law, after



1 first transferring to the General Revenue Fund of the State Apportionment  
2 Fund an amount equivalent to the cost of collection and other charges as also  
3 provided by law.

4 (b)(1)(A) All revenues derived from twenty cents (20¢) per gallon of  
5 the tax levied upon vinous liquor under § 3-7-104(2) shall be deposited in  
6 the State Treasury as special revenues.

7 (B) The net amount thereof shall be credited to the  
8 Arkansas Wine Producers Council Fund to be used according to § 3-5-703.

9 (2) All revenues derived from fifty-five cents (55¢) on each  
10 gallon of vinous liquor under § 3-7-104(2) shall be deposited in the State  
11 Treasury as general revenue.
