24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-15-407, concerning the Arkansas  
27 Comprehensive Testing, Assessment, and Accountability Program test generally,  
28 is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

29 (e) The assessment or testing procedure used under the Arkansas  
30 Comprehensive Testing, Assessment, and Accountability Program for a student  
31 with disabilities, as identified under the Individuals with Disabilities  
32 Education Act codified at 20 U.S.C. § 1400 et seq., as it existed on January  
33 1, 2003, shall be consistent with any accommodations or modifications  
34 required by the student's individualized education plan.
