Purpose. 27 The purpose of this act is to amend Arkansas Code § 12-63-202 to provide that police officers of the Arkansas Military Department may act as 28 29 law enforcement officers on federal or state property located adjoining a 30 military reservation. 31 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 12-63-202 is amended to read as follows: 32 33 12-63-202. Police officers - Appointment - Qualifications - Removal (a) The Adjutant General of Arkansas, as custodian of military 34 35 reservations identified in § 12-63-201, is authorized and empowered to 36 designate and appoint one (1) or more employees as a police officer or

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- 1 officers for each military reservation, who shall be and are constituted
- 2 peace officers under the laws of this state and shall have and possess all
- the powers provided by law for city police, county sheriffs, and state police 3
- 4 officers, to be exercised as required for maintaining the peace, order, the
- regulation of traffic, and the security of state and federal property on the 5
- 6 military reservation and on other real property that is adjoining a military
- reservation that is owned, leased, or otherwise under the legal control of an 7
- 8 instrumentality of the United States or an instrumentality of the State of
- 9 Arkansas, and on which the Adjutant General has undertaken to provide police 10 or security services.
 - (b) All police officers appointed pursuant to this subchapter shall meet the standards and qualifications established by the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training created by § 12-9-103.
 - (c) The Adjutant General shall have the authority to remove such employee or employees from the execution of such designated duties at his pleasure, and the termination of employment as a police officer shall forthwith terminate all peace officer authority of such person.

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- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 12-63-203 is amended to read as follows: Police officers - Powers and duties 12-63-203.
- 21 (a) A police officer appointed pursuant to the authority contained in 22 this subchapter shall, except to the extent otherwise limited by the Adjutant 23 General, protect property, preserve and maintain proper order and decorum, 24 prevent unlawful assemblies and disorderly conduct, exclude and eject persons 25 detrimental to the well-being of the military reservation, and on other real 26 property that is adjoining a military reservation that is owned, leased, or 27 otherwise under the legal control of an instrumentality of the United States or an instrumentality of the State of Arkansas, and on which the Adjutant 28 General has undertaken to provide police or security services in order to
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- 30 prevent trespasses, and regulate the operation and parking of motor vehicles
- 31 upon and in all of the grounds, buildings, improvements, streets, alleys, and
- 32 sidewalks of the military reservation and on other real property that is
- 33 adjoining a military reservation that is owned, leased, or otherwise under
- the legal control of an instrumentality of the United States or an 34
- <u>instrumentality of the State of Arkansas</u>, <u>and o</u>n which the Adjutant General 35
- 36 has undertaken to provide police or security services.

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
